



QIPRA POINTS SCORE FOS:0001

Each year the Queensland Improved Production Racing Association (QIPRA) provides an opportunity for all financial members and new members to nominate and register as competitors in any of the club promoted championships.

These championships, from time to time, may be supported by sponsors at state championship, club championship or local race meeting levels. It is the members responsibility to be aware of the clubs activities in these areas through regular attendance at club meetings.

The QIPRA committee will allocate points for members who nominate and register in any of the following six categories:

Club Championship

Over 2000 cc
Under 2000 cc

Class Championship

0 - 1600 cc Class D
1600 - 2000 cc Class C
2000 - 3000 cc Class B
3000 - 6000 cc Class A

Club Championship Nomination

Nomination in the “*Club Championship*” is by way of the membership renewal form (attached) for the coming financial year. The member will nominate their vehicle engine capacity which will determine the Club Championship the vehicle is eligible for

For new members your application for membership form will need to contain the same information.

The vehicle will be classified in one of two championships:

Over 2000cc Championship or
Under 2000cc Championship

Class Championship Nomination

Nomination in the “*Class Championship*” is by way of the membership renewal form (attached) for the coming financial year. The member shall nominate his vehicle engine capacity and the class he wishes to contest on the application form.

For new members your application for membership form will need to contain the same information.

The vehicle will be classified in one of four class championships:

Class Championship
0 - 1600 cc Class D (Under 1600cc Championship)
1600 - 2000 cc Class C (Under 2000cc Championship)
2000 - 3000 cc Class B (Under 3000cc Championship)
3000 - 6000 cc Class A (Over 3000cc Championship)

Multiple Vehicles / Engines

A member may only nominate a vehicle in one "*Class Championship*". Should a member have multiple vehicles of differing capacities, then that member may nominate each vehicle in the class relative to the engine capacity as fitted to each vehicle.

Should a member have multiple engines of differing capacities, then that member may nominate each engine/vehicle combination in the corresponding class championship based on the engine capacity as fitted to the vehicle.

Multiple nominations will require multiple forms.

No additional charges will apply however, the onus to inform the club lies solely with the member and must inform the committee, by way of a completed application form, of their intentions to change class.

The engine capacity of any nominated vehicle is to be entered as per the current CAMS technical manual, with engine multipliers for, reciprocating naturally aspirated, rotary naturally aspirated, supercharged or turbocharged reciprocating, and supercharged or turbocharged rotary engines, applied.

Eligibility

to be eligible to score points in any of the above championships a member must be financial:

A financial member is:

-) a new member joining the club, anytime during the year
-) an existing member who is financial prior to the close of entries, as prescribed, for the posted first round of the gazetted QIPRA club championship or CAMS QLD Improved Production State Championship whichever is the sooner.

Ineligibility

A member will be ineligible for points in any championship or championship race if:

-) the member is non financial
-) the member is a past member who has rejoined the club after the race meeting
-) the competing vehicle “*on race day*” fails to display the correct livery for / as:

Series sponsor / sponsors
Single race meeting sponsor / sponsors
Directed by the QIPRA committee (appendix A)

-) the member is in breach of NCR82 & NCR88
-) the member is excluded from a race result
-) the member is involved in a protest which has been upheld and the member has been excluded from the race result, either during the meeting or after the meeting
-) the member has been excluded from the race meeting
-) the member has DSQ recorded against his official race result by the official time keeper
-) the member has DNF recorder against his official race result by the official time keeper
-) the member has DNS recorded against his official race result by the official time keeper

note 1:

DSQ -) disqualified
DNF -) did not finish
DNS -) did not start

Past Member -) is a club member who was financial at any time during the twelve months prior to January 1st of the coming financial year.

Points

Points are awarded in the following manner for:

-) each club championship
-) each class championship:

Qualifying

-) 1 point for pole position

Racing (each race)

-) 35 points for 1st
- 30 points for 2nd
- 27 points for 3rd
- 26 points for 4th
- 25 points for 5th
- and so on down to 1 point for 29th
-) position 30th and beyond score 0 (zero)

Points are awarded:

to “the driver of the vehicle as raced in each race on the day”

by “engine capacity of the entered vehicle as raced in each race on the day”
